The dining area sits adjacent to the great room, clearly defined for everyday meals and special occasions, while the kitchen's efficient layout and nearby pantry keep cooking and cleanup organized and streamlined.

Two secondary bedrooms with walk-in closets are grouped together with a shared bath, forming a comfortable guest wing or flexible space for family visits and hobbies. Nearby access to the laundry and garage entry creates a practical transition zone that helps contain shoes, coats, and daily essentials.

Tucked away on the far side of the layout, the primary suite provides a peaceful retreat with a spacious bedroom, dual-sink bath, and generous walk-in closet.
