The Kennedy is designed to keep daily living connected while preserving quiet spaces for work and rest. A long covered front porch leads into a defined entry, where a private study offers a dedicated space for working from home or managing daily tasks. Opposite the study, a formal dining room creates a welcoming setting for holidays and special gatherings while remaining separate from the home's everyday living areas.

Moving further inside, the home opens into a spacious great room and kitchen that form the central hub of activity. A large island anchors the kitchen, keeping cooking and conversation connected to the great room and optional fireplace. Nearby, the breakfast nook sits along the back of the home with direct access to the covered patio—perfect for casual meals, morning

coffee, or easy outdoor entertaining.

Two secondary bedrooms are thoughtfully grouped on one side of the layout with a shared bath, creating a comfortable guest wing for visiting family or flexible hobby space. Their placement keeps guest activity conveniently close to the main living areas while maintaining privacy for the rest of the home.

Set apart on the opposite side, the primary suite offers a peaceful retreat with a spacious bedroom, generous walk-in closet, and well-appointed bath. Entry from the garage passes through the laundry and pantry before reaching the kitchen, creating an efficient everyday transition that helps keep the main living spaces organized and relaxed.
