The Lincoln 2 is thoughtfully arranged so the spaces you use most are positioned along the back of the home—capturing natural light, backyard views, and easy access to the covered patio. A welcoming front porch leads into an entry that feels open yet purposeful. Two secondary bedrooms with a shared bath are grouped near the front, creating a comfortable guest wing or flexible office and hobby spaces that remain separate from the main living areas.

At the center of the home, the kitchen anchors the open-concept great room and dining area. A spacious island faces the living space, keeping the cook connected while providing generous prep and gathering space. The dining area lines the rear wall with direct access to the covered patio, supporting seamless indoor-outdoor living. An

optional fireplace and expansive rear windows add warmth and year-round appeal to the main living space.

Daily routines are streamlined through the two-car garage entry, which connects to a functional laundry and storage area before opening into the kitchen and pantry. This thoughtful transition helps contain coats, shoes, and everyday essentials while keeping the heart of the home organized and inviting.

Privately positioned at the back corner, the primary suite offers a peaceful retreat with a spacious bedroom, walk-in closet, and dual-sink bath with a separate shower. Just steps from the main living areas yet comfortably removed, the Lincoln 2 balances openness, privacy, and connection to the outdoors in a layout designed for lasting comfort.
